Queen Victoria	Victoria was a British Queen who reigned from 1837 to 1901. At the time of her death, she was the longest-reigning British monarch, but she has since been overtaken by Queen Elizabeth II. The 'Victorian' period of history is named after her.	The Tudors are one of the most famous families ever to rule England. They were in power from 1485 when Henry Tudor was crowned King Henry VII, until the time Queen Elizabeth I died, without an heir, in 1603.			
	Tudor toilets were not much more than a hole above the ground. Only rich people had toilets like this.	Like us today, the Tudors enjoyed eating different types of meat. But without fridges and freezers, they would preserve meat by rubbing salt on it.			
Industrial revolution	This happened during Victorian times. Steam engines and machines transformed the way that goods were made and were transported. It transformed England in many ways including where people lived.	If you were a child in Tudor school, you'd better behave! Teachers were very strict and would punish pupils with 50 strokes of the cane. Pupils with wealthy families would often pay for a 'whipping boy' for their child- if the rich child misbehaved, the whipping-boy received the punishment.
