Parent Pay Debts



As you may know, the cost of school dinners has risen to **£3.20**. We understand with the current climate surrounding the cost of living that things will be a bit tight but **would ask that you check that you can pay for your child/children's dinner before ordering one each day.**

When a child has a school lunch and they do not qualify for Free School Meals or Universal Free School Meals (e.g. in Reception or Year 1 or Year 2) it automatically becomes a debt on your parent pay account. This will need **to be paid daily** to keep the debt off your parent pay account. You can top up your child/children's parent pay account each week so that you do not have pay daily if this helps.
