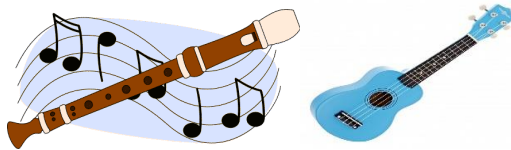




WCET Celebration Concert 2025

Parent Ticket Information & Further Information



Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will already be aware, as part of your child's curriculum they have been learning to play a musical instrument. Hydra have been learning to play the Recorder whilst Draco have been learning to play the Ukulele.

We are delighted to let you know that your child is taking part in the Whole Class Ensemble Teaching (WCET Celebration) Concert at the Symphony Hall, Birmingham, on Monday 16th June 2025, in the 11:00am – 12:00pm session.

We are taking part in this concert to celebrate the musical achievements of the children during their WCET music lessons this year, and this could be a one in life-time opportunity to perform at the world renowned, and prestigious concert hall in Birmingham.

The children will be taken by coach, leaving school at 7:30am and will be back at school before the end of the school day. Your child will need to be at school for 7:15am in the morning so that they can get their instrument ready and go through all the safety checks before the coach leaves.

Please ensure that if your child suffers from travel sickness and would usually have medication for this that this is given to your child in the morning before they arrive at school. The journey to Birmingham will be a long journey, during a very busy time of the working day.

School will be providing a morning snack and a packed lunch for your child along with access to their drinks. **You will therefore not need to send your child into school with any food or refreshments.**

Your child will need to wear their school uniform and will not need to bring any other resources apart from their coat. **All non-essential items will be left on the coach for safety and security.**

Lunch will be eaten on return to the coach after the performance before returning back to school.

The Box Office have been given the seating plans, so may ask you what school you're coming to see; this is to make sure you are given the best viewing option.

Costs for parents and family members are:

- £12 Adults
- £8 Concessions
- £4 Children (18 or under and in full-time Education)

Tickets will be sent electronically by email from, and these can be printed and brought on the day or show the Music Service staff members or 'Front of House' staff an electronic copy of the ticket.

Tickets will be on sale from **Monday 31st March 2025** and will be closed on the day of the concert, where you can purchase directly there if required. However, tickets cannot be guaranteed on the day, so prior booking is recommended. All tickets will allocate a seat so there will be no need to queue for the best seat on arrival.

We look forward to seeing you at the Concert, which promises to be a truly inspiration event for your child.
