### **Educational Workshop from Magic Door Education: Reception and Hyrda**

On **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> October**, Reception and Hydra learners will have the opportunity to enhance their learning, as we have invited Magic Door Education into school to deliver a Florence Nightingale Workshop to complement their learning about the life and times of Florence Nightingale.

"Miss Nightingale" will visit our school and share her experiences. Through role-play, story-telling, opportunities to dress up and to handle artefacts from the time, we explore how she improved hospital conditions in the Crimea and the positive impact she had on the nursing profession. In our very own Barrack Hospital, we'll clean, we'll nurse, we'll "cook" and prepare herbal medicine. Later in the day, we'll discover what happened in Miss Nightingale's story when we returned from the Crimea and how she made positive changes to nursing.
