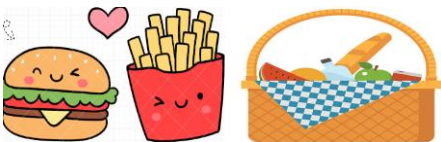
As part of our home learning partnership, your child's task is to design a contribution:
