All learners will need to come to school dressed in their PE kit in the morning. They will not require their school bag on the day. Every child needs to wear their PE pumps, shorts and a plain coloured T-shirt in the team colour that they have been allocated. A text will be sent out indicating your child's team colour.

Please ensure that your child has had sun cream applied before school and that they have a sun cap with them. Sun cream can be sent into school with your child, clearly labelled with their name on it so that they can re-apply this as required during the day.

All visitors will be required to sign in and out of the school premises during the day and a signing in station will be set up by the school field by the Carpark.

A viewing area will be created where Parents/Carers can come forward and watch the children's races, returning to the picnic area once the race has finished. Limited seating will be available in the viewing area, therefore Parents/Carers are advised to bring their own blankets or picnic chairs from home for sitting in designated the picnic area.

Parents/Carers are welcome to bring your own packed lunch and join the children on the field for the picnic if you wish. You are also invited to accompany your child/children with the Fundraising activities in the school hall. Please note that no hot meals will be provided on this day. If your child requires a packed lunch provided by the school kitchen, your child can order this as usual in the morning at school.

As part of our fundraising burgers, hot dogs, chips, ice pops and drinks will be available to buy from the kitchen (cash only) and can be taken outside to enjoy as part of your picnic. Food can be pre-ordered to ensure availability through Parentpay:
